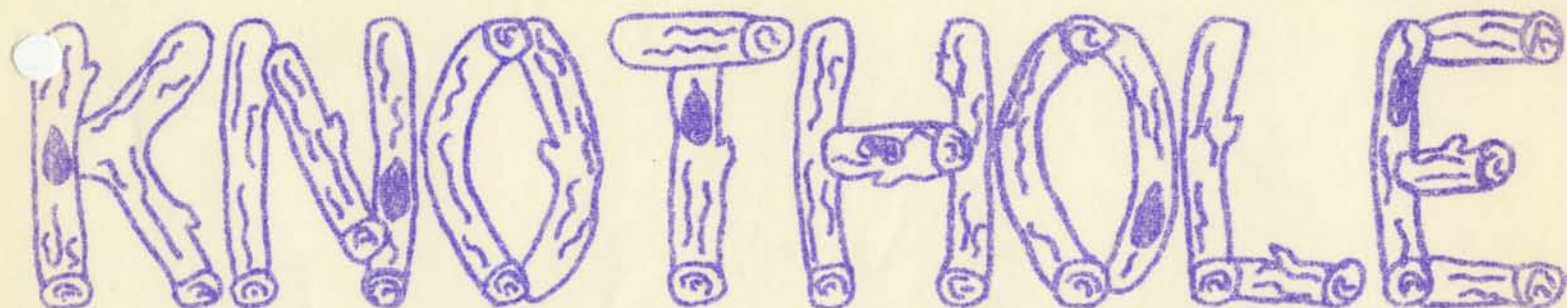

If you plan to be a candidate get in contact with one of these people soon. Your Class Representatives are:

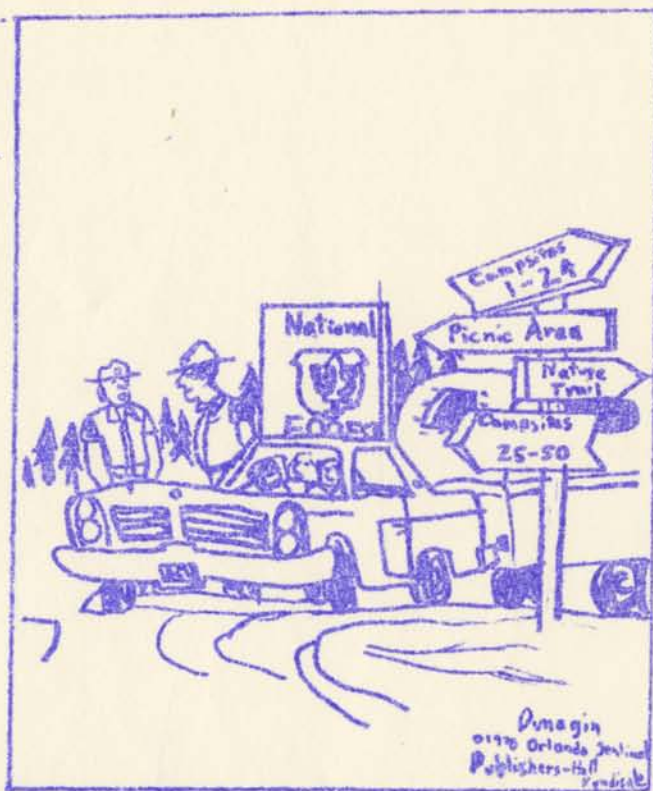
